13. Respondent's publicly posted privacy notice states:
a. "RST [Respondent] will not sell, or otherwise use or disclose" education records for targeted advertising or marketing within its products or institution."²
14. Respondent was never contacted by the NYSED Office of Privacy until after December 2018.
15. The Department finds that Respondent violated § 87(2)(b) and d(5)(c)(2) of NYCRR Sections 121.5, 121.6, and 121.7 by failing to require timely delivery of notifications to educational agencies regarding administrative, technical, and physical security breaches of educational agencies or a breach without unreasonable delay.
16. Respondent acknowledged that it was fully informed of the DPA's position and to avoid the burden and expense of further proceedings, hereby waives any injunctive hearing as may be provided for in the DPA. Respondent consents to and agrees to the entry of a final order of the Department finding the facts set forth in this Order and the validity of the civil penalty imposed by the Department by educational agencies as a result of this breach, which is not an admission of the facts alleged or of liability.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to the same above, that:

and 8 NYCRR Part 121.

1. The amount of \$120,000 will be paid by cashier's check to the New York State Commissioner of Taxation and Finance, as directed by the Office of the Attorney General, described above. Respondent shall pay the civil penalty imposed by this Order.
2. Within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order, Respondent shall provide training, at its own expense, on the federal and state laws and regulations governing confidentiality of personal data and the rights of individuals to access to such data. This training shall minimally encompass FERPA and New York Education Law Section 2-d.
