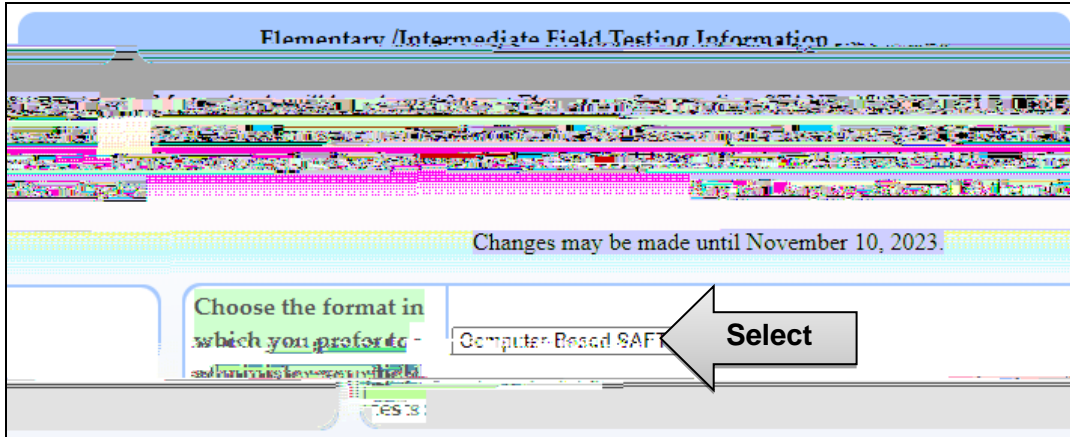


**NYSED Online Examination Request System

1. Select Computer-Based or Paper-Based Stand-Alone Field Test Format (ELA and Math only).




2. Schools that will be administering operational CBT must then select their Lead Scoring Entity.

Alternate language computer editions are no longer available.** When requesting alternate language editions, schools will also receive the corresponding paper copies of the English editions of the tests to provide as a testing accommodation.
