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Dear District Superintendents and School Principals,

As you may know, the 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) Out of School Time program, a federally-supported initiative that is funded through grants allocated by the New York State Education Department (NYSED), is a pilot program

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Participants' classroom teachers (for elementary students), or math and ELA teachers (for middle/high school students), are requested to complete these surveys, although surveying teachers who also provide services to the 21st CCLC program will be avoided where possible.

Program staff will need to work with you or your school-based liaison beginning in early March to identify the appropriate students.

Only teachers of those students who have attended the 21st Century program for at least 10 hours at the time the surveys are administered are asked to participate.

Survey instructions, and all surveys, will be delivered via email by NYSED to identified teachers, who can complete them online. No one at your school will need to be involved in survey delivery or collection.

Surveys will be delivered on Friday May 14, 2021, with a completion deadline of close of business on Friday May 28, 2021.

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
